

## WHITE WINE

### 1. FERNLANDS SAUVIGNON BLANC

NEW ZEALAND 1 £19.95

Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettly herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.95 250ml £6.95

### 2. ALFREDINI GARGANEGA PINOT GRIGIO

ITALY 1 £17.50

Light in colour, refreshing, and crisp and with aromas of limes, grapefruits and lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.25 250ml £5.80

### 3. MICHEL SERVIN BLANC

FRANCE 1 £13.95

Light and straightforward, with an up front nose of citrus fruit, tinged with a subtle leafy character. Crisp and dry on the palate, with a zingy finish.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £3.60 250ml £4.85

### 4. FIVE FOOT TRACK CHARDONNAY

AUSTRALIA 1 £14.95

A nose of citrus fruits and ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. Crisp lemon and lime on the palate, served up with a rounded and buttery feel.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £3.95 250ml £4.95

### 5. CHEMIN DES DAMES DEMI SEC

SOUTH OF FRANCE 2 £14.95

A medium dry wine, offering a fresh aromatic bouquet followed by honeydew melon fruit and an attractive sweetness, with good balancing acidity.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £3.95 250ml £4.95

### 6. VINA CARRASCO SAUVIGNON BLANC

CHILE £16.95

Thoroughly citrusy on the nose, with fresh lime and lemon forming the aromatic backdrop. More citrus on the palate, accompanied by a ripper hint of pineapple, and mouthwatering acidity.

### 7. MACON VILLAGE, CAVE DE LUGNY

BURGUNDY 1 £20.95

Apple and citrus predominate on the palate along with a hint of pear, finishing on a lovely mineral streak.

### 8. CHABLIS DOMAINE SERVIN

BURGUNDY 1 £26.95

Domaine Servin produce wine from their own estate and never sell to negociants - a guarantee of consistency. This can be experienced in the flinty, mineral style with citrus fruit and white flowers.

### 9. SANCERRE ROGER NEVEU

LOIRE 1 £29.95

Aromas of ripe rhubarb and gooseberry leap from the pale lemon coloured glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint. Mineral texture, high acidity, vibrant green fruits and a long, lingering finish.

## DESSERT WINE

### 10. VISTAMAR LATE HARVEST MOSCATEL, HALF BOTTLE

CHILE 7 £13.50

Straw yellow in colour, with golden highlights. Aromas of white flowers, peach, apricots and quince carry through to a palate of more ripe stone fruits and dried fig flavours.

## ROSÉ WINE

### 11. BOIS DES VIOLETTES ROSÉ

SOUTH OF FRANCE 1 £15.95

Bright and crisp, with very subtle strawberry fruit and a refreshing dryness. The small proportion of Muscat adds a dash of juicy grapeyness.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.10 250ml £5.70

### 12. TORRE ALTA PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ

ITALY 1 £17.95

This wine shows why Rosé is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes and a refreshing zing on the palate.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.25 250ml £5.95

### 13. BLUSHMORE WHITE ZINFANDEL

CALIFORNIA 2 £17.95

Bright coral in colour, with a delicious sweetness, offset by a tangy acidity. Intense cherry and raspberry fruit with a fine natural spritz.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.75 250ml £5.95

## RED WINE

### 14. MOUNTAIN VIEW CARMENÈRE

CHILE C £17.50

Full of soft, ripe blackberry and damson fruit, set apart from the norm by subtle earthy, smoky notes, redolent of toast. Rounded yet firm tannins frame the thick and juicy fruit.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.65 250ml £5.80

### 15. SAN MILLAN RIOJA, CRIANZA

SPAIN C £19.95

Aromas of ripe red fruits with a subtle floral bouquet and notes of cinnamon and clove. A soft wine but with good body and structure.

### 16. FIVE FOOT TRACK SHIRAZ

AUSTRALIA C £14.95

A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £3.95 250ml £4.95

### 17. MICHEL SERVIN ROUGE

FRANCE C £13.95

Supple and inviting, this wine blends the soft and jammy raspberry fruit of ripe Grenache with the firming influences of Carignan's blackberry flavours and robust tannin.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £3.60 250ml £4.85

### 18. VINA CARRASCO MERLOT

CHILE £15.95

Aromas of ripe plums and strawberries, a rounded, easy style.

BY THE GLASS: 175ml £4.10 250ml £5.50

### 19. FLOR DEL FUEGO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

CHILE £18.95

Fruity flavours of plum and blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by subtle green-pepper-like savoury tinges. Easy going tannins provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel.

### 20. LES GALETS COTES DU RHONE

RHÔNE D £17.50

Showing gorgeous, succulent notes of red and black berry fruit flavours and a warming hint of spiciness. Soft and supple tannins contribute to a long and rounded finish.

### 21. AIRES ANDINOS MALBEC

ARGENTINA D £19.95

Deep ruby coloured with smoky black fruits of cassis, blackberry and spice. The concentration of the wine performs well above its price point with soft tannins and a long finish.

### 22. PETER LEHMAN BVC CABERNET SAUVIGNON

AUSTRALIA D £22.95

A benchmark Ramissa Cabernet with Blackcurrant aromas, leading on to a palate of juicy fruit and dark chocolate flavours.

## SPARKLING WINE

### 23. PROSECCO LA MARCA TREVISO Quarter Bottle

The perfect apéritif. An elegant prosecco with pear and melon fruit £6.95

characters. Crisp acidity and a persistent fizz.

### 24. PROSECCO CORTE ALTA NV, DOC, ITALY

Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine £20.95

carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.

### 25. RABOSO ROSADO CORTE ALTA NV, ITALY

An elegant and intense bouquet, dry and soft and with fresh peach £22.95

and red berry flavours on the palate and a round and full-bodied structure.

## CHAMPAGNE

### 26. J DE TELMONT GRANDE RÉSERVE NV

One of the few remaining, family owned Champagne houses, De £35.00

Telmont produces this excellent non-vintage in a medium bodied, soft and fruity, classically yeasty style. Fabulous value.

### 27. BOLLINGER SPECIAL CUVÉE NV

A full-bodied Champagne of great class. Delightful pale gold in £52.00

colour, the mousse is light and persistent.

### 28. LAURENT-PERRIER ROSÉ NV

A wonderfully refreshing apéritif, it also works well with a variety of dishes. £72.00
